In a 2014 article in Public Health Reports, Braveman, an APHA member, defined health equity as "social justice in health" and health disparities as the metric used to measure progress toward equity. ... Health departments changing culture.

Social equity certainly has a policy and financial aspect to it, but it goes further than that - there are calls for equity in education and health, for example. What about a definition of social equity as meaning treating people equally? The problem here is that there is a slight difference between "equity" and "equality".

What Is Social Equity?

The review focused on identifying what works in settings approaches to address the social determinants of health inequities, using Fair Foundations: the VicHealth framework for health equity.
