Excrescences on the bark are cut for collecting the sap. *Tsuga canadensis* (hemlock) produces an exudate of resin, which occurs on the stem in reddish brown, opaque, or translucent pieces. *Pinus palustris* (longleaf pine) is a source of turpentine, pine oil, tar, pitch, and rosin.
